

**FISHLAKE PARISH COUNCIL
MINUTES OF THE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON TUESDAY 13TH
OCTOBER 2020 AT 7.00P.M IN THE VILLAGE HALL, FISHLAKE.**

1. **TO RECEIVE APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE.** None.
2. **TO RECEIVE DECLARATIONS OF ANY INTERESTS.**
3. **TO APPROVE THE MINUTES FROM THE FOLLOWING MEETING:**
Approved that the following be accepted as a true record:
 - (a) Parish Council meeting held on 9.9.2020.
4. **TO CONSIDER ACCOUNTS & FINANCIAL MATTERS.** Reported – listed on a separate sheet.
5. **TO CONSIDER ALL ITEMS OF CORRESPONDENCE.** None.
6. **TO CONSIDER ALL PLANNING MATTERS.** None.
7. **TO CONSIDER HIGHWAYS MATTERS.** Reports of potholes and vegetation over growing on Millfield.
It was noted that the roads are still in a terrible state following the flood damage and the Clerk agreed to contact DMBC to see if a schedule of works is in place for improvements.
It was noted that the speed sign on Trundle Lane has been installed in front of the village ‘Welcome to Fishlake’ sign and as a result the village sign is to be moved.
8. **TO CONSIDER IMPROVEMENT PROGRAMME:**
 - (a) Grass cutting – closed season. It was noted that DMBC are doing a good job of the grass verge cutting.
 - (b) Future improvement programme. Nothing to discuss.
9. **TO CONSIDER FISHLAKE PLAYING FIELD MATTERS.** 2 cuts made in error by DMBC earlier in the season meaning a loss of income for PC contractor. Clerk to request DMBC reimburse Mr. Illman for his losses.

Clerk’s note: DMBC refuse to reimburse for cuts made in error.

10. **TO CONSIDER FLOOD PLAN/PREVENTION.** Flood Plan template reviews deadline 26th October.
Comments were made on the disappointment of the resilience sceme, raised with DMMBC who are in agreement.
It was noted that there are discrepancies in the Section 19 report – these were discussed at the multi-agency meeting.
Agreed to push for telemetry in the Ings with DMBC & the EA.
11. **TO CONSIDER POLICE MATTERS/NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH ISSUES.**
Reports of lamping in the village through to Sykehouse and Fosterhouses. Police aware, awaiting action. Noted.

12. **TO RECEIVE A PRESENTATION FROM WILLIAM WILCOCK - SUPERFAST SOUTH YORKSHIRE RE: RURAL BROADBAND.**

Mr. Wilcock explained the scheme to members. The scheme works with Open Reach and DMBC using government vouchers to obtain better fibre broadband connectivity. Residents can apply for a voucher and all vouchers can be pooled together to take advantage of the infrastructure available. The more houses that take part the better as a group project must be formed in order to qualify. Mr. Wilcock said he was happy to obtain a quote from Open Reach on the Parish Council's behalf. Noted.
